- An exposure visit was arranged for the group of farmers form Nilgiris district to M/s Wales Exports Ltd, Pollachi on 04.11.2022.
- Mr.Gautam explained about the ecological systems, cropping pattern and export opportunities of Nilgiris district and its importance. He mentioned about the need for growing organic vegetables and fruits in nilgiris district. Through participative approach, the topic on management of FPOs and group performance were discussed.
