Different types of baskets, light lamps and other decorative products from banana fibres are produced by the trust . They are also providing Workshops on the making of the products..The members of FPOs was delighted to visit and they have informed with the ideas of revenue generation from waste materials. A visit to TVS farm also made to understand different methods they are adopting for crop cultivation and nursery techniques followed by them. The farm is of more than 100 acres and includes Mango, Papaya, Amla, Pomogranate and other horticultural crops. They are maintain a manure production unit and also a nursery Unit inside the farm.
