The Department of Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business - Chennai, funded the project on “Capacity Building Trainings” to members of Farmer Producer Organizations (FPO's) to transform them as Agri Entrepreneurs under the Tamil Nadu Small Farmers Agri Business Consortium (TNSFAC) scheme. In this regard, EDII-Tiruchirappalli Agri Business Incubation Forum (EDII-TABIF) organized three days training programme on “FPO Management” to 40 participants of Karur district FPO's from 02nd to 04th November 2023.

The training program was designed to provide farmer members of Farmer Producer Organizations with comprehensive knowledge and skills for effective management of their Farmer Producer Companies. By offering insights into various aspects of company management, the training aimed to enhance the capacity of farmer members to make informed decisions, implement best practices, and contribute to the sustainable growth and success of their respective organizations. Before commencing the first day's session, participants filled out the Pre-evaluation form, and training kits were provided.

DAY - 1

Session - 1

Date : 02.11.2023

The first session of the day one was handled by Mr. Mohan Karthick - District Development Manager (DDM, Trichy Zone) - NABARD, on the topic “**Creation of Awareness on Government schemes on FPO's**”. In this session he discussed State & Central schemes and policies.

In this session, he created awareness on financial planning - sensitivity analysis, assessment of working capital and means of finance. He covered on the facilities that are available for obtaining loans from various funding sources. He also explained about budgeting and how to handle the grants and loans.

In this session he briefed about the quality certifications viz., AGMARK, FSSAI, ISO, etc., APEDA and export - import licences.
